

INFORMATION / INSTRUCTIONS

Social Security Number: A social security number is REQUIRED the first time you apply for a hunting or fishing license according to s. 29.024(2g), Wis. Stats. Such number WILL NOT be disclosed to any other person except to the Department of Workforce Development to determine liability for unpaid child or family support. Once you have applied for a license, you will be assigned a DNR Customer Number, and only that number will appear in your record.

Eligibility: A minor is only eligible to receive a transferred approval if that minor has not been previously transferred that type of approval. The minor must also be eligible to use the approval.

Fees:

- There is no transfer fee if transferring from a resident to a resident.
- There is no fee rebate if a non-resident transfers the license or permit to a resident.
- If the Transferor of a Bear or Upriver Sturgeon Spearing license is a resident and applies to transfer the approval to a nonresident, the Transferor shall pay, at the time of application, the difference between the fee for a resident and the fee for the nonresident license or permit.
- A transferor may not receive payment or any other form of consideration for the transfer.

Submit: (All of the following)

- This completed application
- Spring - Fall Turkey – Submit the transferor's turkey license, stamp and permit.
- Bobcat / Otter / Fisher / Sharp-tailed Grouse / Horicon-Collins Goose – must submit the transferor's issued permit(s)
- Upriver Sturgeon Spearing – submit the transferor's license
- Bear Hunting License – submit the transferor's license and backtag
- License Fee – Bear and Sturgeon Spearing resident to non-resident only
 - Bear = \$49 and \$251
 - Sturgeon = \$20 and \$65
- Photocopy of transferee's hunter education certificate

Application Deadlines:

- Youth Permit Transfer Applications must be received at least 15 days before the start of the season for which the license or permit is valid.
- Upriver Sturgeon Spearing Youth License Transfer applications must be received 15 days before the start of the season, but no earlier than November 1st of the preceding year.
- The appropriate license or permit will be mailed to the transferee upon application approval. A minor who is transferred a license or permit shall retain all preference points that he or she has previously accumulated.
